Resolution 16-61 Summary

RESOLUTION TITLE: AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE BULK ALUM THROUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING COUNCIL

SUMMARY:

A review of the WVRSA's Fiscal Year 2016 vendor expenditures through June 2016 revealed that the Authority had expended approximately \$34,000 with Seidler Chemical, Inc. for the purchase of alum and that projected expenditures through the end of the Fiscal Year would likely exceed the State's \$40,000 bid threshold.

The WVRSA is a member of the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (administered by the Township of Randolph). Seidler Chemical was awarded an alum contract for 2016 by the Morris County COOP and has charged the WVRSA the same unit price as the Morris County COOP contract.

Resolution 16-61 formalizes the record that purchases of alum through Seidler Chemical, Inc are being made through the Morris County COOP contract. The Resolution therefore documents WVRSA compliance with NJ purchasing regulations.
