

RESOLUTION RE: AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF BULK LIQUID ALUM FROM KEMIRA WATER SOLUTIONS, INC. THROUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING COUNCIL FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2017 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2017

WHEREAS, the Wanaque Valley Regional Sewerage Authority (WVRSa) requires the use of liquid alum as part of its wastewater treatment process; and

WHEREAS, the annual cost of liquid alum required for use by the WVRSa is likely to exceed the bid threshold of \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council was established in 1974 and operates under the guidelines of N.J.S.A. 5:34-7.1; and

WHEREAS, the WVRSa is a member of the Morris County Cooperative Pricing; and

WHEREAS, the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council has awarded contract (MCCPC Contract #14 c) to Kemira Water Solutions, Inc. for bulk liquid alum with minimum deliveries of 4,000 gallons at a price of \$0.8941 per gallon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the WVRSa Board of Commissioners does hereby authorize the purchase of bulk liquid alum from Kemira Water Solutions, Inc. through the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council Contract 14 c for the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.
