

RESOLUTION RE: APPROVING A THREE MONTH EXTENSION TO THE SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF WANAUKE TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES OF LICENSED SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM OPERATOR

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wanaque (the Borough) is in need of a sanitary sewer collection system operator licensed by the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Wanaque Valley Regional Sewerage Authority (the Authority), through an agreement with Chapman Environmental Services Borough of Wanaque has available a licensed sanitary sewer collection system operator to perform services for the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the most recent agreement between the Borough and the Authority expired on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Authority to continue to provide the services of a licensed sanitary sewer collection system operator to the Borough; and


WHEREAS, the terms of a fully renewed agreement between the WWRSA and the Borough has yet to be negotiated; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the WWRSA to extend the current agreement between the WWRSA and the Borough, with all terms and conditions remaining in place, for a period to allow for the negotiation and finalization of a fully renewed agreement for a period yet to be determined.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Wanaque Valley Regional Sewerage Authority as follows.

1. The agreement between the WWRSA and the Borough of Wanaque for the services of a licensed sanitary sewer collection system, which expired on December 31, 2025, be extended for a three (3) month period from January 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026.
2. During this period all terms and conditions of the agreement that expired on December 31, 2025 shall remain in full effect.
3. The WWRSA Interim Executive Director and Director of Finance & Administration are hereby authorized to negotiate a renewed agreement on behalf of the WWRSA with representatives of the Borough.
4. The renewed agreement negotiated shall be subject to the approval of the WWRSA Board of Commissioners and the Wanaque Borough Council.

**WANAQUE VALLEY
REGIONAL SEWERAGE AUTHORITY
SERVICE AGREEMENT
SEWER OPERATIONS**

THIS AGREEMENT, effective October 1, 2023, is by and between the **WANAQUE VALLEY REGIONAL SEWERAGE AUTHORITY** ("WVRSA") and the Borough of Wanaque, New Jersey ("Borough").

WITNESSETH that the WVRSA and the Borough, each in consideration of the agreements on the part of the other set forth below, agree as follows:

Location of services to be performed

The WVRSA shall provide the Borough with services for sewer collection systems operations relative to existing sanitary sewer collection system and appurtenances owned and operated by the Borough.

Standard Services

The WVRSA shall provide the services of a sewer collection system operator with all licenses required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP). Said services shall be provided by Chapman Environmental Services, as the Authority's contracted licensed operator, in accordance with the scope of work and fee schedule attached to, and made part of, this Agreement.

General Provisions

The WVRSA shall take all necessary and available measures to ensure that services to the Borough hereunder are in compliance with all applicable rules and regulations promulgated by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, and any other agency or entity vested with jurisdiction regarding the services that are the subject of this Agreement.

The parties may amend this Agreement in writing at any time upon mutual consent. Any such amendment shall not be effective until ratified by both parties.

The WVRSA shall maintain supervision, responsibility, and control over all personnel and/or contractors providing services pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

Liability & Indemnification

The Borough will hold the WVRSA harmless for damages caused by the WVRSA's failure to authorize and/or undertake any repairs, replacements and/or maintenance, provided that (A) this Agreement does not provide for said repairs, replacements and/or maintenance, and (B)
